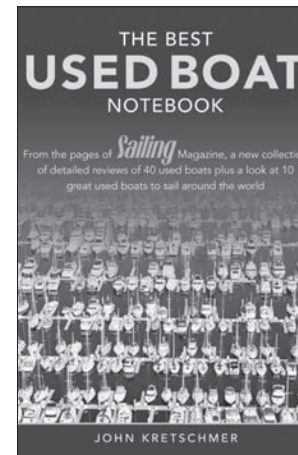
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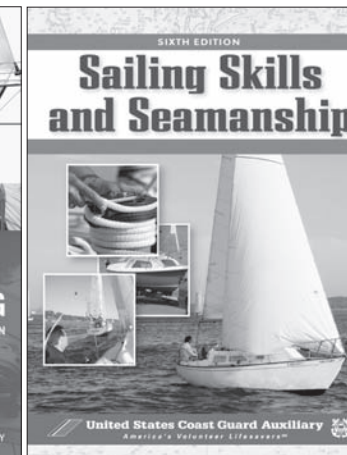
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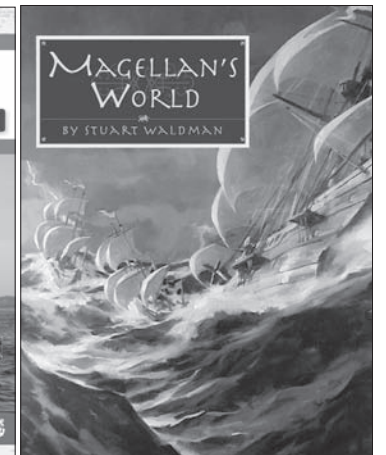
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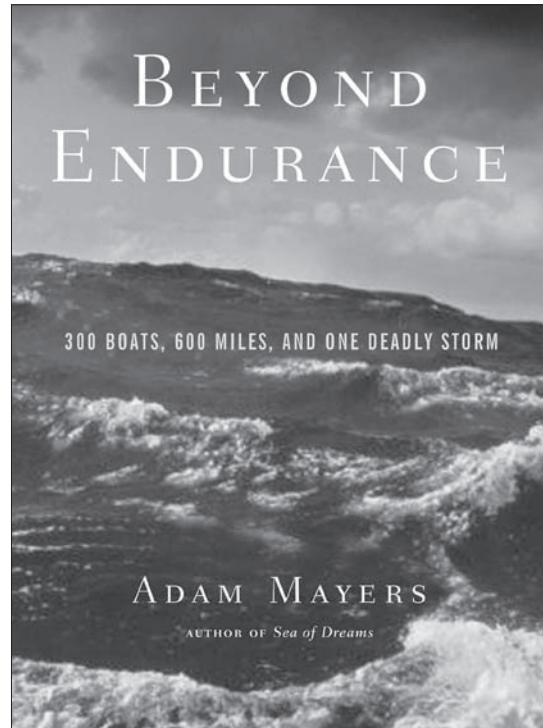
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The Power and the Glory

The disastrous 1979 Fastnet race is infamous among sailors. A Force 10 storm killed 15 men, wrecked five boats, and caused 15 more to be abandoned. Among the survivors were 26 sailors from Canada and the U.S., all of whom were interviewed for this fascinating home-grown take on the race. Ten months later they again attempted the Horn, and were again capsized, dismasted, and nearly sunk.
